In front of the museum, you will also find an extraordinary floating heritage : the three-master ship *Duchesse Anne* and the lightship *Sandettié*, both listed as historical monuments, as well as the barge *Guilde*. These ships allow you to embark on a discovery of the world of sailors and boatmen.

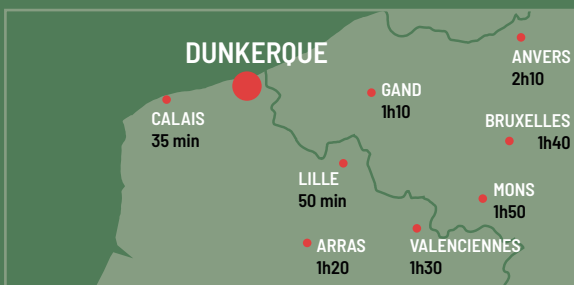
Finally, the Risban lighthouse, located 2 kilometres from the museum, offers a spectacular view of the area.

To continue that experience, enjoy **exclusive tours in the port area**. Led by former port workers, **you will get to the heart of the activities in the port of Dunkirk**.

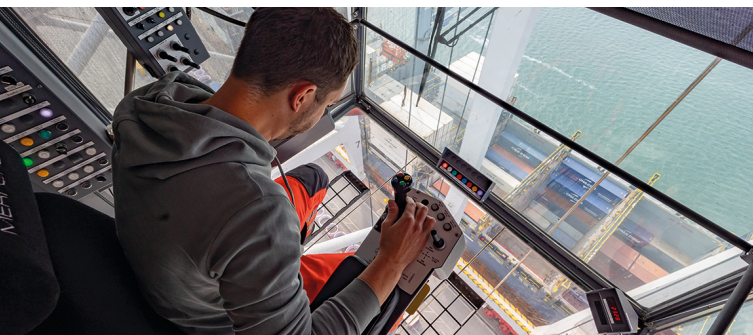
A truly unique experience is guaranteed !
